# KIU TUITION FEE LOAN SCHEME

This is to inform the entire University Community and the general public that Kampala International University in collaboration with Orient Bank (Bank PHB Uganda) has inaugurated Tuition Fee Loan Scheme. The Scheme is designed to help students and their parents to meet the primary cost of Education in KIU. This include:

The Scheme does not cover accommodation, books and living costs

### 1. Eligibility

All students of KIU who are East African Citizens and hold a students saving Account with Orient Bank Ltd are eligibility to apply.

### 2. Loan amount

The maximum loan amount is pegged on the amount of fees the university charges per programmes / course in a given period (year) of study.

### 3. Terms and Conditions

The general terms and conditions shall be applicable to the borrower's i.e. the parents, guardians and working students of KIU.

- Completed application form
- Letter of undertaking from employer confirming the applicant's salary, regular allowances, gratuity, any terminal benefits payable at the time of applying for a loan.
- Employment contract (where applicable)
- Valid Identification together with the latest original pay slip
- Certified copy of six (6) months statement from current bankers
- Proof of income
- Proof of residence (utility bills)
- The student's admission letter
- The student's identity card
- Borrowers & student shall have saving accounts held at Orient Bank
- 2 Passport photos of borrowers and student
- Loan tenor not to exceed 12 months for each approval done (six months per disbursement)
- Evidence of consistency of income, if any
- Undertaking from University for the students
- Map to borrower's residence
