

Message FROM THE CHAIRMAN BOARD OF TRUSTEES

ON THE 24RD GRADUATION CEREMONY OF KAMPALA INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY HELD ON 20th NOVEMBER 2021

nce again, the Almighty God has given us another opportunity to celebrate the achievements of KIU in the form of the second graduation ceremony in 2021. I welcome you all to the third virtual graduation ceremony held by Kampala International University. What began as unfamiliar territory triggered by the COVID-19 outbreak in 2020 is turning out to be part of normal business in our institution. I would like to appreciate all stakeholders who have made it possible for this 24th graduation ceremony to happen today, despite the challenges and limitations.

Mr. Chancellor Sir, allow me to address myself to a few notable points as my remarks on this occasion.

1. COMMITMENT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES DESPITE ECONOMIC DOWNTURN

As I noted in my speech during the graduation ceremony held in April 2021, it is common knowledge that COVID-19 disrupted everything. I emphasized how private universities were severely affected and KIU was no exception. I indicated how the Board of Trustees was forced to suspend some aspects of the much needed infrastructural development in order to sustain the institution's essential recurrent budget. On this note, I am happy to note that the Board of Trustees has had to make certain tactical and strategic interventions to revamp the institution's operations through alternative financing models, thus mitigating the financial shock to a sustainable level. Against all odds, KIU has ensured that no staff gets laid off or have their contract suspended due to the financial challenges. We remain committed to staff and students

2.INFRASTRUCTURAL DEVELOPMENT

Mr. Chancellor Sir, am also happy to note that owing to the alternative financing models mentioned in the foregoing submission, the Board of Trustees has managed to sustain certain critical

infrastructural development projects in motion. During the last couple of months, the following projects have been accomplished:

- a) State-of-the-art e-learning studio at Kampala Main Campus, worth over two hundred thousands Euros (200,000), with a matching grant from NUFFIC (Netherlands) DISH Project in which KIU is part of the Presidency and as a dutch Partner with Tilburg University.
- b) Restructuring and equipping of KIU teaching hospital, notably with a CT Scan, MRI and Ultrasound machines, among others.
- c) Continued construction and general repairs at the teaching hospital
- d) Completion of the Engineering blocks at Western Campus
- e) Completion of the Biomedical labs at Western Campus
- f) Completion of 2 blocks for offices and classrooms at Western Campus

In addition, the following are new projects at their take off stage:

- a) Construction of a new Library at Western Campus
- b) Construction of a sports complex at Western Campus
- c) More investment in technology, especially for programmes that require hands-on practical exposure.

3. RESEARCH, INNOVATION, CONSULTANCY AND EXTENSION

I would like to thank the University Council for the foresightedness in recently moving to establish a Committee of the University Council on Research, Innovation, Consultancy and Extension. In my view, this has been a missing link. It is only through pushing the research and innovation frontier that KIU will become as impactful and globally reputed as we envision it to be. The new Committee will ensure that the KIU fully benefits from the wealth of expertise, experience and

networks of Council members in this area.

4. APPRECIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY COUNCIL, MANAGEMENT AND STAFF

Recent world university rankings put KIU in the second position among universities in Uganda. The University has over the past couple of years consistently featured among the top 4 universities as far as these rankings are concerned. As a result, KIU has over the past four years become a popular destination for foreign institutions seeking to establish collaborations. Indeed we are beginning to harness the benefits of those collaborations. This certainly points to a job well done on the part of the University Council, Management and Staff.

I wish to particularly appreciate Prof. Fred Wabwire-Mangeni, Chairman of the University Council who has been particularly handy, cooperative and responsive whenever duty calls. Similarly, Prof. Jessica Nakavuma, chairperson of the Appointments and Promotions Committee of the University Council has been equally committed, even in odd timings. Am happy to note that even throughout the hardest lock-down phase, the KIU Council has never failed to duly transact its business. If it meant transacting virtually, they did. I thank all members of Council for this expression of commitment and sacrifice.

What I have said of the University Council is even truer for the Management and staff. I dare say that the glorious ranking that KIU glides in today, is a result of painful sacrifice by the staff. Throughout the two years of the disruption induced by COVID-19, KIU staff have been busy working under hard circumstances. People have had to patiently take pay cuts when the situation dictated so. While staff in many other institutions were in doubt over technology as a substitute for face-to-face operations, KIU staff swiftly moved to embrace it. I am informed that research output by staff was at its peak during the lock down, and this is largely responsible for the status of the ranking.

I would like to thank the Vice Chancellor Prof. Mouhamad Mpezamihigo and his team to know that their commitment and sacrifice is not going unnoticed. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I reiterate our commitment to continuously improving the working conditions, and at

the opportune time, to duly recognize those outstanding among you.

5. APPRECIATION TO PARENTS/SPONSORS AND STUDENTS

There is a saying, "If you want to know how good the soup tastes, you don't ask the waiter or chef; you ask the customer". This saying captures the story of KIU. The public is the unbiased customer. Since 2001, KIU has been a popular destination for students from over 20 countries. I thank and congratulate today's graduating class and their sponsors for having chosen KIU. Remember that the true value of your university qualification is not what is written on the certificate and the transcript, but the true value is the knowledge and skills you translate into action to add value to other people's lives.

The University degree, diploma or certificate does not guarantee you any status; it is the difference you make in other people's lives that defines your status in society. If you want to be great in life, be of great service to other people. For most of you, when you are a student, you receive support because you are an entitled dependent. But now your status has changed. You have completed your school work for this phase. The real work of your life now is to continuously figure out how you can apply what you know to serve others. In the real life after school, you get in proportion to what you give, there is no more entitlement.

6. CONCLUSION

The Board of Trustees would like to thank all stakeholders, including the relevant government ministries and departments for the continued support and cooperation. We remain committed to contributing significantly to the development of higher education in Uganda and Africa through consistently transforming KIU into a world-class university. We will continue to bank on your support and quidance.

Message FROM UNIVERSITY MANAGEMENT

Let me also deliver the sincere apologies of the Chancellor, Prof Mahmood Mamdani, who for unavoidable reasons is unable to preside over this ceremony. He has delegated me as the Vice Chancellor, to preside over and fulfill the statutory requirements, as provided for in the University Charter (2009), Article 41, clause 2(e), that states,

"in the absence of the Chancellor, the Vice Chancellor shall preside over ceremonial assemblies and confer degrees and other academic titles and distinctions of the University Charter".

I thank the Chancellor for his continuous support and guidance in his oversight functions to the University. He has advised that, "it is worthwhile for graduands and all our participants in today's ceremony to reflect on the effects of the never-ending pandemic and plan effective strategies on how to deal with this protracted crisis as part of a larger community".

I warmly welcome our Chief Guest, and thank him for accepting to officiate at this graduation ceremony despite his busy schedule.

I also take this opportunity to thank the Chairman Board of Trustees Al-Haj Dr Hassan Basajjabalaba, and Members of the Board for the continued financial and material support, and for creating an enabling environment of mutual consultations, guidance and continuous dialogue for the smooth running and good progress of the University.

Let me sincerely thank Prof Fred Wabwire-Manghen, the Chairperson and Members of the University Council and recognize each member's contribution despite their heavy national and international obligations.

I applaud Members of the University Senate and Management at both the main and western campuses for being part of my dynamic and highly focused team. Your efforts are hereby recognized. Please carry on and do not tire. I also thank all staff (academic, administrative and support) who have shown the highest level of resilience in the hard times. Indeed you are the fittest amidst the turbulent and tough Covid-19 situation. You have sacrificed your all, to keep KIU flying high. We can only say to you, "Thank you and Congratulations for demonstrating your unwavering commitments to the institution".

I warmly welcome the team of TAC Volunteers and those about to join the KIU fraternity as supported by the Federal Government of Nigeria. So far 21 have arrived, while about 30 more will be arriving before the end of November 202, all adding to our human resources. Uganda is a very hospitable country, please enjoy your service at KIU and the community at large. We will be there to assist you to quickly settle. We are indeed grateful to the government of Nigeria through the Nigeria High Commission and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of both Uganda and Nigeria. In the same vein, I welcome all new staff and thank all those who continue to serve or have served the University in the recent past.

On this occasion, I would like to thank all our continuing students and the Guild Leaders for being resilient, listening and understanding. I know, there are a number of inconveniences that have a risen out of the new normal and a number of disruptions in your studies. For example, some of you, were unable to take advantage of the online learning and assessments. Others faced different forms of challenges. These are not in anyway deliberate or intended, but are a consequence of the pandemic. Our experiences make us better by the day and all we need from you is to keep your feedback flowing to the relevant University offices as we try to fix all issues that may hinder or delay your academic progress.

What does the future hold amidst the persistent Covid-19 Pandemic disruptions?-

The outbreak of the pandemic has shown that the human race remains prone to natural occurrences. Covid-19 has leveled all of us to be universal, at the least, the scare it has caused has made all of us to

have a common focus on the importance of our existence. Indeed the fight against Covid-19 is an existential one, regardless of your location in the World.

Although it has caused devastation in education, like many other sectors of life, it is not all bad because some opportunities have come to surface. For example, previously, education institutions, particularly in Africa and some Asian countries, attached little or no importance to the uptake of digital technologies as a tool to enhance teaching, research and community outreaches. Under the current circumstances, it is no longer an option. Just like the importance attached to physical infrastructure prior to the pandemic, it is now prudent for institutional investments in ICTs and Digital Technologies in a collaborative way.

In my recent inaugural lecture for my Professorship from the Academic Union of Oxford, I proposed the concept of *Cooperation and not Competition* as the way to go in the globalized world. The other idea is to apply what I term *reverse linkages* in which institutions that are advanced in some aspects and niches collaborate with those that need to be uplifted. At the national level, the KIU University Council has directed that the University Management seeks to establish partnerships with institutions in Uganda, as we continue to pursue international partners.

In this spirit, through a memorandum of understanding and agreement between Islamic University in Uganda (IUIU) and KIU, the Board of Trustees has offered 24 graduate scholarships to build the capacity of IUIU Medical School and their upcoming Faculty of Engineering and Technology. Selected staff of IUIU will pursue Masters Degrees in Medicine, Biomedical Sciences and Engineering at KIU. We already have memoranda of Understanding with Kyambogo University and other institutions in Uganda, in addition to IUIU.

Resilience builds hope

At KIU, we have continued to reconfigure our systems to cope with the new normal. Our students and staff have showed the highest level of resilience in the current circumstances and for that we are grateful. The basics of evolution speak to survival for the fittest, and at the moment, institutions have a huge task to sustain their survival.

Many students may have fallen victims of temporary diversion from their education dreams. For instance, we have had stories of young girls becoming mothers, while young boys have fast tracked their ascendance to fatherhood. Such young parents need psycho-social support to help them juggle their new roles and continuity of their education aspirations. My advice to the affected individuals is to get back to school when the opportunity avails itself, and plan accordingly, while parents, quardians and sponsors are called upon to restart their support to students to ensure the dreams are realized. There is a need for all of us to embrace technology, and for sponsors, quardians and parents not to take the acquisition of smart gadgets as a luxury anymore, but a necessity and a must have for the student. This will facilitate the quick uptake of technology to facilitate learning. Come to KIU and lets talk and find a solution together. Our admissions are open for new intakes.

Research and Publications

I take this opportunity to congratulate all our staff who continue to publish their scholarly works and contributing to global knowledge. Our research output continues to improve significantly and recognized on the global scene. The University hopes to increase its research budget and vibrancy to meet the research budget demands, especially for Covid-19 related interventional research, and with the guidance of the Council Committee of Research and Innovation.

Conclusion

The University appreciates the Government of Uganda, Federal Government of Nigeria, Foreign Embassies, local, regional and International government and non-government organization for the collaborations and partnerships with KIU. I thank the visionary Board of Trustees (BOT), led by the Chairman, Al-Hajj Dr. Hassan Basajjabalaba, the Chancellor, the Chairperson and members of the University Council and the management team, Academic, Administrative and Support Staff. Your contributions have made the difference in the advancement of the University. We also thank all our other partners in Uganda, East Africa and beyond for making KIU a formidable partner.

I once again congratulate all the graduands for reaching this day. Please remember you have but only a limited time to enjoy your life and therefore quard it jealously.

I wish you all the best and encourage you to remain our good KIU ambassadors.


